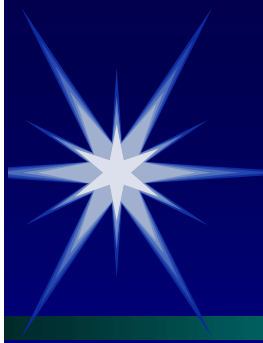
Building a profitable company is one of the hardest things to do
